For :

- Children who understand and speak German.
- Kindergarten - 3rd Grade.

Primary Goals:

- Provide German language instruction for children in a professional and friendly way.
- Develop the students' German writing, reading and speaking skills.

Accomplished through:

- School curriculum follows the curriculum of the state of Baden Württemberg.
- Students are separated into classes of Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grade.
- Preschool (ages 2.5 - 4) will be offered if enough students enroll.

Other:

- Meets Saturday, 9:30 a.m. - 12 noon.
- Twice/month, about 20 times/year.
- Why Saturday: Students are rested and more receptive to instruction than they would be in an afternoon program.
- Cost: registration fee: \$50/family, tuition: \$35 per Saturday, and fee for books.
